Our 50 acre estate, originally landscaped by Mr. Grieve in 1874, is a short stroll from the picturesque town of Duffoch, in the heart of Perthshire. Recreating the glorious gardens and relaxing surroundings that were part of the original vision for the Atholl Palace has been our passion.

The remarkable specimen trees, planted as the hotel was being built, have become a Red Oak, an undiscovered caryophyllus and include Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar and a Giant Sequoia. These fine big trees, happily sit alongside an outcrop of ancient woodland oaks and more formal gardens such as the Japanese Garden, Front Lawn and Herbaceous border and the South Terrace Garden.

Visitors to our Kitchen Herb Garden are rewarded with a litany of colour, seasonal vegetables, herbs, fruit, bees and cutting heds. Quietly nestled beside old Victorian garden walls, it makes a happy place to relax and relax.

Our gardeners' hard work and imaginative planting has been celebrated with several prizes from the 'Pillachy in Bloom' competition over the last few years.

Within the walls of the former Victorian Walled garden you will find our children's playground, additional car parking and the Atholl Palace Lodges.



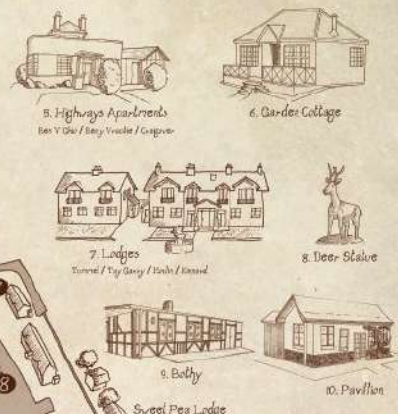
PERTSHIRE'S BIG TREE COUNTRY

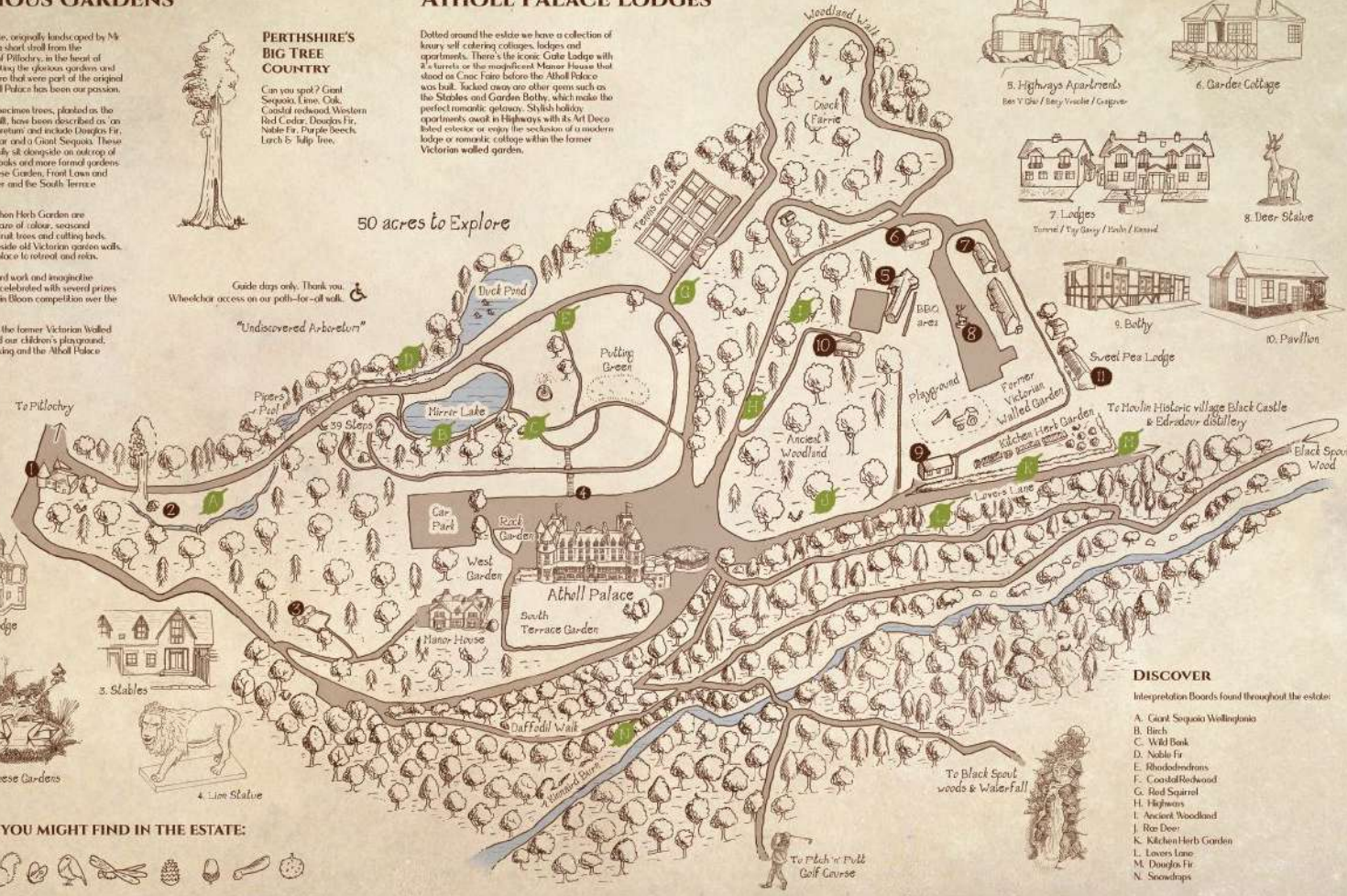
