'50 Acres to Explore'

Our 50 acre estate, originally landscaped by Mr Gorrie in 1874, is a short stroll from the picturesque town of Pitlochry, in the heart of Perthshire. Recreating the glorious gardens and relaxing atmosphere that were part of the original vision for the Atholl Palace has been our passion.

'Undiscovered Arboretum'

The remarkable specimen trees, planted as the hotel was being built, have been described as 'an undiscovered arboretum' and include Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar and a Giant Sequoia. These fine big trees happily sit alongside an outcrop of ancient woodland oaks and more formal gardens such as the Japanese Garden, Front Lawn and Herbaceous border and the South Terrace Garden.

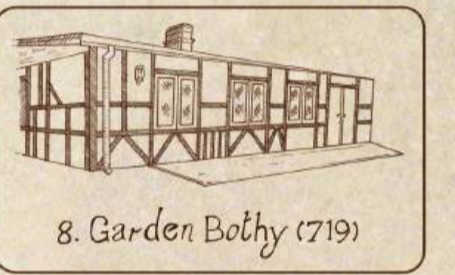
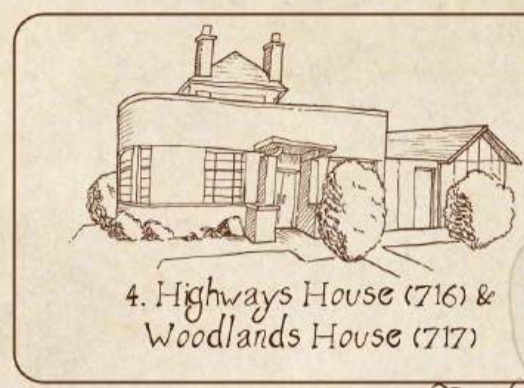
Our gardeners' hard work and imaginative planting has been celebrated with several prizes from the Pitlochry in Bloom competition over the last few years.
